It is recommended for the person invited to supplicate for his host after finishing eating his food as was the practice of the Messenger (salla Allahu alayhi wa sallam).

Learn a duaa for your host.

Here is one below, but there are others:

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَهُمْ فِي مَا رَزَقْتَهُمْ،
وَ اغْفِرْ لَهُمْ وَ ارْحَمْهُمْ

'O Allaah, bless for them, that which You have provided them, forgive them and have mercy upon them.'

Allahumma baarik lahum feemaa razaqtahum wagfir lahum warhamhum

OR

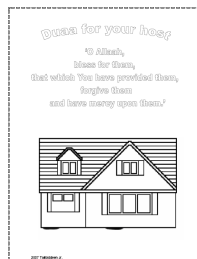
Have you had someone come over for Ramadan dinner this year?
